PAINTING OF MALAYSIAN FLAG AND THE WORDING 'MALAYSIA' ON AIRCRAFT REGISTERED IN MALAYSIA.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The purpose of this Notice is to inform aircraft owners and operators of additional markings requirement that is mandatory for aircraft operating on the Malaysian Civil Aircraft Registry.
- 1.2 The Minister of Transport has directed that all aircraft owned by public companies in Malaysia be painted with the Malaysian Flag and the wording 'MALAYSIA' on both sides of aircraft fuselage.

2. Applicability

- 2.1 All aircraft registered in Malaysia and eligible for a Certificate of Airworthiness.

3. Requirement

- 3.1 Malaysian Flag and the wording 'MALAYSIA' shall be painted on both sides of the fuselage, preferably towards the front or nose of the aircraft.
- 3.2 These additional markings shall be of appropriate dimension in relation to the aircraft size. The markings shall also be in contrast to the background.

4. Compliance

- 4.1 Compliance to this Notice is effective immediately.
- 4.2 Aircraft operators and owners are required to schedule their aircraft to comply with the above requirement as soon as possible.
