Launch of Air Navigation Service Providers' Newsletter

15 JULY 2015

Greetings from Air Traffic Inspectorate Division, DCA, also known as *Bahagian Inspektorat Trafik Udara* (BIT).

In launching *Safety BITes* as an information tool, this newsletter is intended as a communication means to disseminate, alert and educate Air Navigation Service (ANS) Providers, of essential information, as quickly and clearly as possible.

As the ANS regulator for ANS providers in Malaysia, the BIT uses a variety of means to develop, establish and document the related ANS requirements currently applicable in Malaysia, in order to ensure compliance with national legislation, international standards and industry's best practices. The publications by the BIT include the *ANS Regulatory Manual* [which contains the requirements and procedures pertaining to the provision of ANS - based mainly on the standards and recommendation of *International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Annexes to the Chicago Convention*, other ICAO documents and best practices], and may be supplemented by the *Air Traffic Inspectorate Directives* (ATIDs) or *Aeronautical Information Circulars* (AICs). Where appropriate, the ATIDs and AICs may be incorporated into the Manual by amendments.

In line with *ICAO Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (USOAP)* activities where ANS compasses seven fields, namely *Air Traffic Management (ATM)*, *Procedures for ANS-Aircraft Operations (PANS-OPS)*, *Aeronautical Information Services (AIS)*, *Aeronautical Charts (Chart)*, *Communication Navigation and Surveillance (CNS)*, *Aeronautical Meteorology (MET)* and *Search and Rescue (SAR)*, the BIT conducts regular safety oversight audits/inspections of all ANS providers.

Currently, the ANS providers in Malaysia are the Air Traffic Management Sector of DCA, the Malaysia Meteorological Department, the Royal Malaysia Air Force and the Malaysian Army.
