## CONTINUATION OF DCA AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE LICENCE (AML) EXAMINATION SERVICES

---

### 1. Purpose

- 1.1 This leaflet is issued to notify that the current DCAM Part 66 examinations being conducted at all DCA examination centres will be continued under a new arrangement.

### 2. Examination Services Transition

- 2.1 DCA had contracted Civil Aviation Authority International (CAAi) to provide DCAM Part 66 examinations, allowing the usage of a maximum of 10,000 papers over a period of 5 years, will end by January 2018. During this contract period the examination fees are subsidised by the government.
- 2.2 However, it is estimated that the 10,000 papers will be fully consumed by end of 2017.
- 2.3 After December 2017 or, after complete usage of 10,000 papers, whichever earlier, DCA will continue to provide examinations with CAAi under a new arrangement, without the subsidy.
- 2.4 There will be no significant difference to the examination procedures except for changes of the examination fees.

### 3. Changes in Examination Fees

- 3.1 Under the current contract, the actual cost of the 10,000 papers had already been paid (subsidised) by the government. Candidates are only required to pay RM 100 per paper.
- 3.2 Under a new arrangement, examination candidates will have to pay the actual cost of each examination paper applied for, including the RM 100 per paper, the amount of which will be prescribed in the examination portal.
